DOG PARK MEMBERSHIPS

WHERE TO REGISTER

Purchase membership at City Park Ranger Station or Western Branch Community Center, during normal working hours.

(Call for hours; may not be available weekends.)

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

- ♥ Dog owner purchasing membership must be at least 18-yrs-old.
- ♥ Male dogs over 1-yr must be neutered.
- ♥ Dogs must be at least 4-months-old.
- ♥ Dog owner must provide proof of animal registration with dog tag number from city/county residence.
- ♥ Dog owner must provide a current "Certificate of Vaccination" documenting immunizations with expiration dates for rabies, bordetella, distemper, and parvovirus vaccinations.
- ♥ Tags must be displayed on dog(s) at all times.

MEMBERSHIP FEES

- \$10 for January–December; \$5 each additional dog.
- If purchased June 30, or after, \$5 for remainder of year; \$2.50 each additional dog.
- To receive multiple-dog discount, membership must be purchased at same time.
- Visitor pass—\$5.

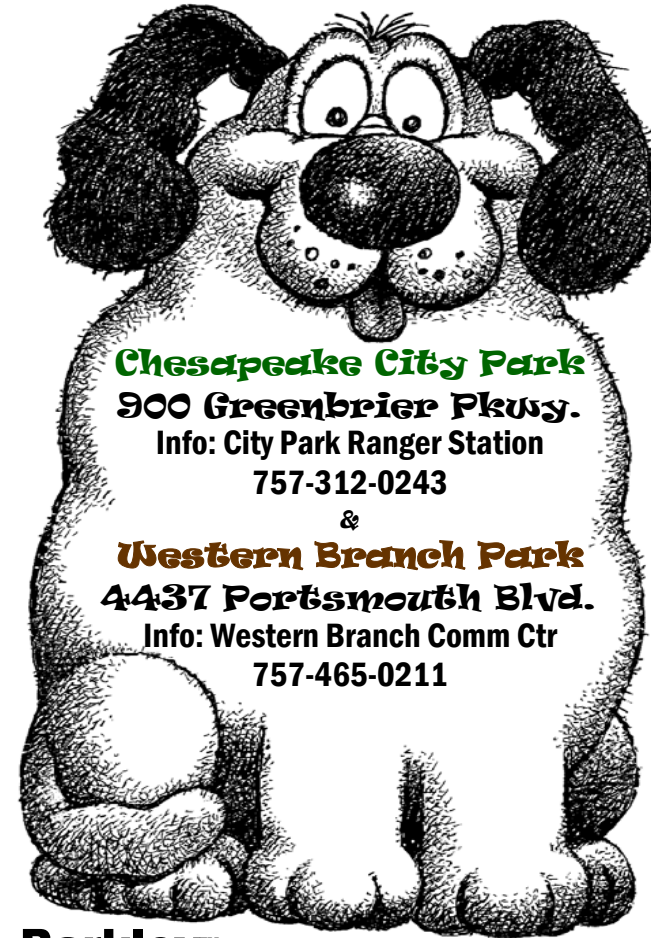

City of Chesapeake Dog Park Ordinance

Section 50-22 Domestic animals; dog parks.

- (a) No person shall bring or be responsible for the entry of a dog or other domestic animal into areas other than automobile parking concourses and walks immediately adjacent thereto and in such other areas as may be clearly marked by signs. Except in an area specifically designated as a Dog Park, subject to paragraphs (b) and c) of this section, nothing in this section shall be construed as permitting the running of dogs at large. All dogs in those areas, other than dog parks, where such animals are permitted shall be restrained at all times on adequate leashes not greater than five feet in length.
- (b) A "dog park" is a fenced or otherwise enclosed area within a city park that is clearly marked by signs posted in the area, where dogs are allowed to be released from leashes.
- (c) Any owner or other person bringing a dog or dogs to the dog park (the "responsible party") shall be legally responsible for any injury, property damage, or other loss caused by the dog or dogs in his or her care.
- (d) The city, in creating dog parks, relies upon all immunities existing at common law and by statute, including, but not limited to Virginia Code 15.2-1809.
- (e) Access to and continuing use of dog parks is conditioned upon the following:
 - (1) All dogs must be licensed, vaccinated, and wear a collar with identification and current tags.
 - (2) The responsible party must carry a leash at all times and remain with the dog in the dog park. Leashes should be removed immediately upon entrance to the dog park, and dogs must be leashed when removed from the dog park.
 - (3) Dangerous dogs and vicious dogs as defined in section 10-47.1 are prohibited. Dogs must be removed at the first sign of dangerous behavior toward people or other dogs.
 - (4) Dogs that are ill, less than four months of age, an unneutered male over the age of one and female and in heat are prohibited from entering a dog park.
 - (5) The responsible party must clean up and dispose of waste left by their dogs and provide any necessary equipment for removal and disposal.
 - (6) Children under eight years of age are not permitted in the dog park except during approved events or activities sanctioned by the city.
 - (7) No responsible party shall be in possession of more than three dogs at a time within the dog park.
 - (8) Responsible parties must prevent dogs from digging within the dog park and immediately refill any holes.
 - (9) No food, drink, or tobacco products are allowed within the enclosed area of the dog park.
- (f) Violation of any of these rules is cause for expulsion of the dog and the responsible party from the dog park. In addition, violation of any of the items set forth in paragraph (e) is a class 3 misdemeanor.
- (g) The department of parks and recreation may impose any additional rules and regulations it deems necessary to ensure safe and efficient usage of the dog park.

City of Chesapeake



Section 10-45 Domestic, companion, wild or exotic animals constituting a public nuisance.

(a) No owner shall fail to exercise proper care and control of his or her domestic, companion, wild or exotic animal to prevent it from becoming a public nuisance. Acts deemed nuisances shall include but are not limited to: excessive, continuous or untimely barking, molesting passerby, chasing vehicles, attacking other animals as to cause injury or death, trespassing upon school grounds or private property in such a manner as to damage property, habitually running at large.



Section 10-23 Defecation.

It shall be unlawful for any owner or person in control of any animal to:

- (a) allow any animal to defecate on the property of other persons without their consent or that of the authorized agent or person having control of the premises; or
- (b) allow any animal to defecate on public property, except that by an animal shall not constitute a violation of this subsection if the owner or person having control of the animal immediately removes the material defecated and disposes of it in a safe and sanitary manner.



VIRGINIA STATE CODE - Recreation Use Immunity State Code 15.2-1809. Liability of localities in the operation of parks, recreational facilities, and playgrounds.

◆ No city or town which operates any park, recreational facility, or playground shall be liable in any civil action or proceeding for damages resulting from any injury to the person or from a loss of or damage to the property of any person caused by any act or omission constituting ordinary negligence on the part of any officer or agent of such city or town in the maintenance or operation of any such park, recreational facility, or playground. Every such city or town shall, however, be liable in damages for the gross negligence of any of its officers or agents in the maintenance or operation of any such park, recreational facility, or playground.

◆ The immunity created by this section is hereby conferred upon counties in addition to and not limiting on, other immunity existing at common law or by statute.

General Guidelines

- 🐕 Please be a responsible dog owner and follow all posted rules.
- 🐕 Dog owners are required to license and vaccinate their dogs and have proof while at the Park.
- 🐕 Dog owners will be liable for the full value of any Park property damaged by their dogs.
- 🐕 Park staff will monitor and spot-check usage, licenses, and compliance with Dog Park rules and ordinances.

Dog Park Rules

Keep your dog and you Safe and Happy

Dog Dos

- 🐕 **DO** clean up after your dog(s).
- 🐕 **DO** have a collar with proper tags showing licensing and immunization proof on your dog at all times.
- 🐕 **DO** watch & keep an eye on your dog. Stay with your dog at all times.
- 🐕 **DO** everything to avoid dog fights. If a fight starts, pull the dogs apart from the back.
- 🐕 **DO** teach your dog to play quietly. Barking or uncontrollable dogs must be removed.
- 🐕 **DO** remove your dog immediately at the first sign of aggressive behavior toward people or other dogs.
- 🐕 **DO** leash your dog before you leave the Dog Park.
- 🐕 **DO** have an adult accompany dogs and children at all times.

Dog Don'ts

- 🐕 **DON'T** bring dogs that are sick into the Park.
- 🐕 **DON'T** bring female dogs in heat into the Park.
- 🐕 **DON'T** bring male dogs over 1-year-of-age that have not been neutered.
- 🐕 **DON'T** let your dog dig holes.
- 🐕 **DON'T** leave your dogs unattended in the Park at any time.
- 🐕 **DON'T** bring children under age eight into the Park.
- 🐕 **DON'T** feed your dog in the Park.
- 🐕 **DON'T** have a leash on your dog while in the Dog Park.
